LOCAL LEAGUE RULES

- A RIF Safety ball shall be used.
- Games last 1 hour, no new inning shall start after 50 minutes.
- Only 10 players on the field for defense at a time. Extra players can be substituted during the game.
- Teams will only bat the same number of players each inning, i.e. if one team has 9 players and the other 12, only 9 players will bat per inning.
- Each team will bat through the entire lineup every inning. After three outs, the bases will be cleared, but the batting order will continue.
- Coaches will be pitching to their own team. The player will have 5 pitches to hit the ball unless the 5th pitch is fouled off then they will get one more.
- The coach must not interfere with the others team's ability to field the ball.
- The coach should be trying to pitch the boys over handed but if they cannot do it, they may pitch underhanded.
- No stealing nor will any advance on: throwbacks to pitchers, dropped 3rd strikes, passed balls.
- Infield fly rule is not in effect.
- No bunting, if this happens replay the pitch.
- Time will be called when the ball reaches the infield and is controlled by any infield player.
- Helmets with facemasks are optional. USA bats only. (No USSSA bats. Wood bats allowed if USA stamped)
- Home team is designated as the 2^{nd} team listed on the schedule. (A v H)

SPORTSMANSHIP

Sportsmanship is non-negotiable. Parents, coaches, players or other spectators are to act in a respectful and sporty manner or will face consequences. If it is discovered that parents, coaches, players or other spectators are acting in an unsportsmanlike manner, FCPR and the Director of FCPR reserve the right to suspend or punish the offending party appropriately.

Players, coaches, parents, or spectators that are ejected will be suspended for 2 subsequent games following the ejection. Receiving 2 ejections within the same year will result in removal from the program.
