### **LOCAL LEAGUE RULES:**

TIME LIMIT: Games consist of six full innings or a 1 hour and 45-minute time limit. No new inning will start after 1 hour and 30 minutes. In case of a tie game, the game ends in a tie.

LIGHTENING: If the umpire witnesses lightning, each area shall wait at least 30 minutes from the last lightning strike. No area shall permit players to return to the field less than 30 minutes from the last visible lightning strike.

MERCY RULE: Fifteen run rule in effect after 3 innings and ten-run rule in effect after 4 innings.

**RUNS PER INNING: Five-run rule max per inning, including the last inning.**

OUTFIELDERS: Teams may use four outfielders during the regular season.

BATTING ORDER: Teams must use a continuous batting order.

BORROW PLAYERS: A team can play with eight players, or they may borrow one player from another team to make nine. Teams can borrow up to two players only. Anything less than seven players must be forfeited or rescheduled. If you borrow a player, they must bat at the end of the order, play in the outfield, and cannot pitch. Teams cannot borrow players if they have nine players.

SUBSTITUTIONS: Free substitution on defense.

MANDATORY PLAY RULE: All players must play at least 1 innings in the field and bat one time.

CAL RIPKEN PITCHING RULES: Six innings per week, (Mon-Sun) applies as well as new pitch count rules. Cal Ripken Baseball pitchers must have two-calendar days rest between pitching assignments if he/she pitches in more than two innings in one game. "No pitches" as called by the umpire count towards the overall pitch count. Warm-up pitches do not. It is the obligation of the HOME book to track the pitch count of each team. We highly encourage each manager to check with the OFFICIAL scorekeeper between innings to insure both teams have the same pitch count recorded. However, if there is a discrepancy of some sort, the HOME book will be the official book. Coaches/scorekeepers may use any method to track pitch counts.

BASE RUNNING: Runners shall not leave base until the pitch crosses home plate. Once the ball crosses home plate they are able to steal.

BATS: All legal bats must have the USA Baseball marking on the bat.

PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR: Shall be worn on deck, at bat, while a baserunner, and by players in coaches' box at all practices and games. Such headgear must cover the top of the head and properly fits the player wearing it. Full facemask helmets are still allowed.

COURTESY RUNNER: At any time, the team at bat may use courtesy runner for the catcher in order to speed up the game and give the catcher a break.

All other rules shall follow Cal Ripken Baseball.
