

Floyd County Parks and Recreation Release of Liability

IN CONSIDERATION OF my child/ward, being allowed to participate in any way in the Floyd County Recreation Department's related events and activities, the undersigned acknowledges, appreciates and agrees that:

The risk of injury to my child from the activities involved in these programs is significant, including the potential for permanent disability and death, and while particular rules, equipment and personal discipline may reduce this risk, the risk of serious injury does exist; and

1. FOR MYSELF, SPOUSE AND CHILD, I KNOWINGLY AND FREELY ASSUME ALL SUCH RISK, both known and unknown, EVEN IF ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES or others, and assume full responsibility for my child's participation; and
2. I willingly agree to comply with the programs' stated and customary terms and conditions for participation. If I observe any unusual significant concern in my child's readiness for participation and/or in the program itself, I will remove my child from the participation and bring such to the attention of the nearest official immediately; and
3. I myself, my spouse, my child, and on behalf of my/our heirs, assigns, personal representative and next of kin, HEREBY RELEASE AND HOLD HARMLESS the Floyd County Recreation Department, its Board of Supervisors, Administration, Directors, Officers, Officials, Agents, Employees, Volunteers, Other Participants, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, advertisers, and if applicable, owners and lessors of premises used to conduct the events ("Releasees") WITH RESPECT TO ANY AND ALL INJURY, DISABILITY, DEATH or loss or damage to person or property incident to my child's involvement or participation in these programs, WHETHER ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES OR OTHERWISE, to the fullest extent permitted by law.
4. I, for myself, my spouse, my child, and on behalf of my/our heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin, HEREBY AGREE TO INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS all the above Releasees from any and all liabilities incident to my involvement or participation in these programs, EVEN IF ARISING FROM THEIR NEGLIGENCE, to the fullest extent permitted by law.
5. For myself, spouse and child, i knowingly and freely assume all such risk, both known and unknown regarding potential COVID-19 exposure. Recreational sports carry inherent risk and I understand that my/my child's participation in recreational activities may expose me/my families/releasee's to COVID-19.

BY AGREEING, I HAVE READ THIS RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK AGREEMENT, FULLY UNDERSTAND ITS TERMS, UNDERSTAND THAT I HAVE GIVEN UP SUBSTANTIAL RIGHTS BY SIGNING IT AND SIGN IT FREELY AND VOLUNTARILY WITHOUT ANY INDUCEMENT.

Floyd County Parks and Recreation Parent Code of Conduct

Floyd County Parks and Recreation is dedicated to providing a safe, productive, and welcoming environment for all county participants including, but not limited to, full & part time staff, volunteers, parents & guardians, youth, game officials and all other citizens involved in our scope of services. Participants are expected to abide by this Code of Conduct throughout all Floyd County Parks and Recreation facilities, live and virtual events, programs, activities, and online platforms.

Floyd County Parks and Recreation and the County of Floyd has zero-tolerance for any form of discrimination, harassment, and unacceptable behaviors such as unsportsmanlike conduct.

Unacceptable Behavior is defined as:

- Harassment, intimidation, or discrimination in any form
- Verbal abuse of any youth, volunteer, staff member, game officials, service provider or other spectators in attendance.
- Examples of verbal abuse include, aggressive or threatening behavior included but not limited to foul language; verbal comments related to race, gender, sexual orientation, disability, physical appearance, body size, religion, and national origin; inappropriate physical appearance including inappropriate attire; and threatening or stalking of any individual.
- Theft or damage of any/all property including facilities and sports equipment

If a participant engages in harassing behavior, whether in person or virtually, Floyd County Parks and Recreation reserves the right to take any action deemed necessary and appropriate including their immediate removal of participants from the event/league without warning or refund. Breaches of this Code of Conduct may result in disqualification from attending and participating in future programs, activities, and events sponsored by Floyd County Parks and Recreation.

The Floyd County Parks and Recreation Department strives to create an environment in which all citizens feel safe and supported during the duration of services. All individuals interacting with Floyd County Parks and Recreation services agrees to immediately bring all questions, concerns, and grievances to a full-time staff member of the department.
