LOCAL LEAGUE RULES:

Innings/Time Limit: 6 innings or 2-hour drop dead time limit (games can go extra if time allows)

Runs/inning: 7 runs max per inning rule, including last inning

Mercy Rule: 15 after 3, 10 after 4

Borrowed Players: must bat last and play outfield

Bats: **The BBCOR Standard:** All non-wood, metal, or composite bats must be BBCOR certified. A clearly visible BBCOR .50 certification mark must be permanently stamped on the bat. The "drop" (length in inches minus weight in ounces) cannot be greater than -3. For example, a 33-inch bat must weigh at least 30 ounces. The barrel must be 2 5/8 inches in diameter. Bats cannot be longer than 36 inches or shorter than 26 inches.

Pitching: A pitcher's required rest is based on their total pitch count for a single day:

- **101 or more pitches:** 4 calendar days of rest
- **76 to 100 pitches:** 3 calendar days of rest
- **51 to 75 pitches:** 2 calendar days of rest
- **26 to 50 pitches:** 1 calendar day of rest
- **1 to 25 pitches:** No rest required
- **Two-Day Limit:** No pitcher may throw more than 51 pitches over two consecutive days. If they do, 1 calendar day of rest is required.
- **Calendar Day Definition:** A calendar day of rest begins at midnight and does not include the day the pitches were thrown (e.g., if a pitcher throws 76 pitches on Tuesday, they cannot pitch again until Saturday).
