LOCAL TEEBALL RULES

- Teeball is essentially a 3-inning exhibition or a 1-hour time limit. Teeball is about having fun and learning.
- Every player on the team will be put in the batting order and will bat in his/her proper order. For each half-inning, all the batters on the batting team will bat. When the entire batting order has batted, the half-inning is over, and the other team comes to bat. When the last batter is up each half-inning, the scorekeeper should declare “last batter”. When the defensive team records an out, that player may stay on base and run the bases.
- The batter will swing at the ball until it is hit past the arc. If the batter hits only the tee or the ball does not travel past the arc, the ball is dead, and the batter will try again.
- The infield will consist of four (4) players and a pitcher near the pitching rubber/mound. Each team will use the remaining players as outfielders. Outfielders must be in the grass not the dirt. **The ball becomes dead when an infielder or pitcher has control of the ball in the infield.** Outfielders must throw the ball into the infielders.
- 60ft baselines, Base stealing is not permitted.
- A defensive coach may go on the field to instruct his or her players but may not touch them while the ball is in play. Only one coach is allowed on the infield at a time.
- An offensive coach will help their batter’s bat by placing ball on the tee and instructing them when to hit.
- The defensive team’s pitcher must stay at the mound/pitching rubber until the batter makes contact with the ball.
- The infield fly rule is not in effect.
- Helmets with facemasks are optional. USA bats only.
- If a team is missing players, they may borrow players from the other team in order for the game to process. The goal is to avoid forfeits as much as possible.

SPORTSMANSHIP

Sportsmanship is non-negotiable. Parents, coaches, players or other spectators are to act in a respectful and sporty manner or will face consequences. If it is discovered that parents, coaches, players or other spectators are acting in an unsportsmanlike manner, FCPR and the Director of FCPR reserve the right to suspend or punish the offending party appropriately.

Players, coaches, parents, or spectators that are ejected will be suspended for 2 subsequent games following the ejection. Receiving 2 ejections within the same year will result in removal from the program.
